	<ul> <li>Facilitates care to communities without a local provider, and/or reaching patients who are home-bound or in natural settings (e.g. school)</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Data suggests we can do most of what is needed via telepsych; need to work closely with partner teams who have hands-on presence</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>UH Dept. of Pscyhiatry works with Child and Adolescent Mental Health Division, Family Guidance Centers, on a contract (not fee for service)</li> </ul>
