Treasury: Dr. Aulwes	<ul> <li>Budget is in the black.</li> <li>Dr. Aulwes drafted a spending policy document. Discussion was held regarding the language of the policy. Dr. Akaka suggested a small group to iron out the language.</li> <li>Dr. Akaka recommends setting up a finance and budget committee. Discussion that the Treasurer serves that purpose currently.</li> </ul>	Dr. Aulwes will send updated language to executive committee.

Membership: Dr. Gise, Dr. Smith	<ul> <li>Dr. Akaka made a motion, seconded by Dr. Aulwes, to pay Crossroads for 2018, per the plan outlined in the CALF grant. The motion passed without objection.</li> <li>Dr. Akaka made a second motion, seconded by Dr. Ona, that HPMA pay HMA for their lobbyist's activities for 2017. The motion passed without objection.</li> <li>Dr. Akaka made a third motion, seconded by Dr. Tanqueco, that HPMA enter negotiations with HMA to support the HMA lobbyist for 2018. The motion passed without objection.</li> <li>Dr. Akaka made a fourth motion, seconded by Dr. Ona, to continue working with HMA for administrative assistance through 2018. The motion passed without objection.</li> <li>Discussion was held about current expenses and monies available through budget and CALF grant.</li> <li>Dr. Smith reported membership numbers: 170 currently. Membership has decreased over the last 2 years approx 60 members.</li> </ul>

Communications/Public Affairs Chair: Dr. Danz	<ul> <li>Private practice survey regarding barriers to providing quality care:         <ul> <li>9 responses</li> <li>Highlights were: prior authorizations, documentation/red tape, billing complications, increasing costs without increasing revenue</li> </ul> </li> <li>Dr. Champion reflected that these are issues are consistent with concerns brought up in medicine in general, and that HMA is also focusing on such concerns</li> </ul>

NEW BUSINESS	<ul> <li>Management company Transfer: <ul> <li>Audit process to be finalized and completed</li> </ul> </li> <li>HMSA reimbursement models: no news, but HMA is still involved</li> <li>Physician burnout: the topic is coming up in multiple arenas. <ul> <li>At Hawaii workforce summit, there was a presentation that Dr. Champion found very informative</li> <li>Hot topics: consider how to schedule hot topics in the future</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	
NEW BUSINESS	<ul> <li>Healthcare Association of Hawaii is wondering about psychiatrists interested in collaborative care, PASSRII forms, and home visits for home bound patients</li> <li>Question from Dr. Suzuki regarding getting money, etc. from pharma companies, and how it is recorded and documented.</li> <li>Dr. Ona brought up the news recently regarding a psychiatrist accused of child abuse, and wondering if HPMA should respond to the news. Dr. Smith to look into whether the MD was an APA member.</li> </ul>
