Communications/Public Affairs Chair: Dr. Danz	<ul> <li>Committee on Women: Dr. Danz proposed setting an annual budget of \$250-\$500. Dr. Danz also recommended to include the chair of the Committee on the HPMA leadership web page in order to give it more permanence.</li> <li>Recommended to form connection with a national committee/organization.</li> <li>Motion made by Dr. Danz for the Treasurer to allocate \$500 annually for meetings, to allow the chair to plan meetings. The motion was seconded by multiple members, and was passed by a majority of voting members present.</li> <li>The Executive Council voted to establish to make the Committee on Women a formal Committee and to have the chair listed on the website.</li> </ul>	Update the website for committee.

Related resolution from Dr. Akaka was not forwarded in the legislature.</li> <li>Psychology prescribing bill from last year's legislative session was not brought back. This year's bill changed to a study group, but did not have another hearing.</li> <li>Network adequacy bill passed last session. A related bill related to an audit of providers is moving through.</li> <li>Mental health task force chaired by Rep. Mizuno. HPMA has started to participate in that.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
